

### ***Stop 1/6. Parutino***

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The stratotype of the Bugsky horizon (Veklich, Sirenko, 1972) is located near the northern outskirts of Parutino and represents a natural outcrop on the erosional shore of Dniepero-Bugsky Liman. The slope reaches 17-20 m height. The stratigraphic section reveals the Upper Pleistocene loess-paleosol formations overlying Pliocene-Quaternary fluvio-lacustrine sediments (Fig. 6). It, in turn, is overlain by Dofinophinovskaya or Bryanskaya (Velichko, 1990) soil with a date of 26-30 ky BP.
